ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Academic Session begins in the 1st week of April every year.
- First priority is given to the wards of serving Army personnel including DSC(Ex-Army), wards of Army widows and wards of those TA Personnel who have a minimum of 5 years embodied service.

ENTRANCE TEST

- Admission tests will be conducted, wherever it is applicable as per AWES rules.
- Admission tests are conducted in the last week of March for admission to various classes for the new session.
- Application form, duly completed should be submitted to the school office on or before the prescribed date.
- Late submission of application form will not be entertained.

Admission is given to wards of serving Army personnel coming on transfer from outstation at any time during the academic session. Wards of TA,DSC (Army), Ex-Serviceman (Army) are also eligible for admission. Depending on availability, up to a maximum of 20% seats are given to civilian children. Merit is the main criterion for admission of civilian children. For admission to class I, a student should have completed 6 years of age on 31 March of the academic year in which admission is sought.

SERVING DEFENCE PERSONNEL

- Photocopy of Part II Order/ Birth Certificate signed by the CO/OC unit
- Countersigned TC
- Report Card of previous Class
- Serving certificate of father

TC FROM OTHER SCHOOL

 The District Education Officer of the District in which the school is located shall endorse TC in respect of candidates coming from schools other than APS/KVs. The endorsement should clearly indicate whether it is a recognized school.

The minimum percentages/grades for allocation of different streams for Class XI for Army Students are given below. However admission will depend on relative merit and availability of seats.
